Dolphin deck helps create a garden haven

When a family from Sheet, Hampshire, wanted to reinvigorate their deck in their back garden, William Sutton Landscaping was quick to answer their call.

William explained: "I suggested IRO timber decking in Dolphin grey was the way to go. It's a natural timber product that is charred and brushed. It repels water, and the client was really keen to avoid the composite route".


The client was keen to use a natural product with character. Due to IRO's intricate manufacturing process, the product has an enhanced grain appearance.

The project took just three weeks, with the installation taking just one week. Created in a tight 22m² space, it now complements the wider garden.

The garden's poor drainage meant that the decking had to be constructed on a substructure that would sit above the ground.

"These conditions meant that IRO was the ideal option – it needs to be treated well, but it comes with a specially formulated cream which enables it to repel, rather than absorb water."

"We all lead busy lives, but the bonus of IRO is that it doesn't need too much work to keep it fresh. You can use the touch-up cream by simply wiping it onto the surface of the decking and then removing any excess with a clean cloth. The cream brings out the silver tones that the dolphin decking captures and keeps the timber wellmanaged," said William.





Creating a Gold medal garden at Chelsea Flower Show

A Garden Sanctuary by Hamptons', which used IRO cladding and decking, claimed a gold medal at this year's RHS Chelsea Flower Show. It was a project born out of partnerships, with Koto Design and IRO Timber's relationship spanning several years. Koto's co-founder Zoe Little and her team collaborated with award-winning garden designer, Tony Woods to create beautiful and multi-functional cabin space.

The brief

Working with Woods, and sponsored by Hamptons, Koto wanted to create a place to meditate, an immersive space to connect with nature, and ultimately, a garden sanctuary. 'A Sanctuary by Hamptons' was born. The project embraced the beauty of relaxation in response to an increased desire for more space – especially garden space. Pulling on the IRO Timber team's expertise, Koto made use of charred IRO cladding and decking, with the quality of a stunning charcoal finish elevating the space and demonstrating a high level of craftsmanship throughout the structure.

"We originally chose the charred IRO cladding and decking exterior as it draws from Japanese design influence and the ancient Japanese philosophy Yakisugi, the age-old method of enhancing timber with heat, yet it is manufactured in the UK", explained Zoe.

The impact

Crafted from IRO Timber, the structure is completely natural, with the cabin topped with external decorative cladding. A rich interior colour palette was chosen to enhance the architectural space as the Japaneseinspired timber, which draws from ancient philosophy Wabi Sabi, built a focus on accepting the transient nature of life.

The result is an elegant and functional sculptural geometric form with open and bright glazing, which frames the immersive views the garden bestows. It wasn't just the visitors to the Chelsea Flower Show, but also the judges, who recognised the bold project with a Gold award in the Chelsea Sanctuary Garden 2022 category.

Zoe added: "We are thrilled that 'A Garden Sanctuary by Hamptons' achieved a prestigious gold medal win at this year's RHS Chelsea Flower Show! It was incredible to see our collaborative work received so well by so many at an internationally significant show."

IRO internal cladding completes ambitious home renovation

Based in the stunning Staffordshire countryside, Tom and Sian recently took on the exciting project of renovating a 1750's property into their dream home. With rolling hills surrounding the property, it was important for the owners to bring nature inside and look for natural products to fit with the old-fashioned beams and stunning scenery.

As Tom and Sian started working their way through the property, it was soon time to complete the bathroom and add the final pieces to the bedroom.

Tom did his research and found IRO internal cladding. When he learned how versatile the product was, and how many different colours were available, he requested samples via the website and decided which colours best suited his vision. Tom opted for Driftwood to create a bed headboard and Dolphin to clad the bathroom.

The benefits

It was important to pick a natural product to create a relaxing environment where Tom and Sian could relax. Tom said: "We have a daily commute to and from the city, so it was essential for us to build an environment which allows us to switch off from the hectic 9-5 work life. It was vital for us to create a home where we can wind down and also focus.

Timber cladding has been shown to have many health benefits, such as reducing stress, increasing productivity and improving mood. It's also a carbon-friendly material as trees naturally absorb CO2 and release oxygen, balancing any emissions far better than other building materials.

The design

Tom added: "I installed the headboard cladding horizontally - it suited the bedroom design best. I opted for driftwood as it gave me a blank canvas to work with, meaning we could incorporate bolder tones into the overall design.

"I installed the Dolphin cladding vertically, it helped make the bathroom feel spacious. Dolphin has a light shimmer to it, and i've not seen anything like this on the market before.

"Next year's project is the garden, and I would love to use IRO decking – I would highly recommend it."

IRO is placed in a depressurized holding tank that vacuums the air from the timber cells, allowing them to be replaced with preservative treatment This stage further protects IRO against rot and insect attack.

The amount of water present in wood can affect its weight, strength, workability, and movement. We kiln-dry IRO to lower the moisture content. providing more stability in the product.

IRO is then put through a secondary kilning process to remove any residual surface moisture. This is essential to ensure optimum bonding of the cream during the coating process.

03 Charred

The charring stage gives IRO its beautiful enhanced grain appearance and closes the outer cell structure, making it more durable and protecting it against rot, insects and weathering



Wire brushes scrape away the surface layer of the softer wood to expose the darker latewood. creating more texture by exposing an enhanced grain. This stage improves the appearance of our products.



07 Cream Applied

Finally, a wood cream is applied. This step gives IRO its stunning colour, and provides it with UV stability and water-repellent properties, meaning water will pearl on the surface rather than soak into the material.

Versatile and interesting ways to install IRO products – the choice is yours

Vertical

Vertical cladding is less conventional but will accentuate the height of your space. Once your battens are up, you will then be ready to install the cladding battens.

Horizontal

Horizontal cladding is generally more popular and considered a more traditional choice when installing cladding. Boards are then easily fixed to the battens in a straight line.

Board on board


Board-on-board installation is constructed with an overlapping pattern of vertical boards. Fixings used to install the top board must never pass through the underside board.

Traditional

The standard installation method is typically the go-to method when installing decking. Lay the boards down flat and fix them.

Diagonal

This technique entails installing decking at a 45-degree angle across the joists. Using diagonal decking increases the strength of the deck frame.
